

# Download 30 338 Win Mag Sierra Manual

No personal experience with the 30-338, but I would expect your case capacity to be a little less, so probably a little less velocity. You will end up with a longer neck though, and that is one thing that always bugged me about the Win Mag. Buying three powders these days to find one that works is kinda pricey. In 45 years of handloading, for several dz different rifles, H4831 has turned in top accuracy for me in heavy hunting loads and magnums, more than any other powder, followed closely by H4350.
