Description and use. Although some sources place the origin of the sasumata in the Muromachi period, most sources discuss its use in the Edo period. In Edo period Japan the samurai were in charge of police operations. Jitte may have a small pointed tip or blade attached to the handle (tsuka) and hidden in the shaft (boshin).
